

GOLD CREEK BASALT COLUMN



Description: Gold Creek Basalt Columns feature a variety of hues and colors including rust, orange, and silver with spots of black. Multi-colored swirling patterns are typically visible in the exterior crust. Gold Creek basalt is mostly columnar in shape and hexagonal in form. Available uncored as placement pieces or drilled for water features.

Color: Tans, rusty browns, and reds, oranges, silver, and black make up the coloration of the exterior crust, while the interior is a dark, charcoal grey and can be polished to a black luster.

Diameter: 5" up to 12"

Height: Up to 6'

Weight: ~20 - 125 lbs per linear foot
